Students will continue to work on skills introduced during the previous weeks of prekindergarten as well as those listed below.

UNITS: GROWING PLANTS, NURTURING THE EARTH, AMAZING ANIMALS and CHALLENGES AND EXPLORATIONS

KEY CONCEPTS: SIMILARITIES and DIFFERENCES and WHOLE-PART-WHOLE

READING/ WRITING

- Recognize and blend two phonemes into words with pictorial support
- Combines onset and rime to make short words without pictorial support
- Uses information learned from books

MATH

- Use informal strategies to share or divide up to 10 items
- Child recognizes and compares heights or lengths of people or objects
- Child informally recognizes and compares weights of objects or people

SCIENCE

- Identifies and describes characteristics of organisms
- Describes the life cycle of organisms
- Recognizes the relationship of organisms to their environments
- Identifies, compares and discusses earth materials
- Recognizes and informally compares lengths, heights, weights
- Uses measuring tools
