


Firefox - Manage Pop-up Blocker


To manage the pop-ups on Firefox, you may need to add sites to the exceptions. To do so,

- 1) With Firefox open, click “Tools” on the menu bar.
- 2) Click Options at the bottom of the menu.
- 3) Now click Content in the left menu.





- 4) The Pop-ups option should be checked, then the Exceptions button.
- 5) You can add the site address and click the Allow button to allow pop-ups from that site and Save the changes.

- 6) You will see the list of sites that have been set as exceptions in the window and can edit by removing one or all from the exception list.



Pop-up Blockers

Note: If you get a message for a **Pop-up blocker** – you must “Allow” for all programs you will access. If you get a popup window like the one of the examples shown here, click the “Allow pop-ups for lhub.lisd.local.”



- 1) Type in your assigned username and password for that program in the Manage Password window.
- 2) From now on, your username and password for that program will be remembered and you will not have to enter it each time you log in.
