LISD STUDENTS SCORE HIGHER THAN STATE AND NATIONAL AVERAGES ON COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAMS

The Lewisville Independent School District’s students continue to excel beyond both the national and state averages on the ACT and SAT tests.

Students scored 88 points higher than the national average and 118 points more than the state average on the SAT. On the ACT test, LISD scores are .7 points above the national average and 1.4 points higher than the state average. A total of 1,828 LISD students were tested on the SAT and 1,455 took the ACT.
