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LISD RANKED ‘SUPERIOR’ IN FINANCIAL RATING

Flower Mound, TX – The Lewisville Independent School District recently received a rating of “Superior Achievement” under Texas’ Schools FIRST financial accountability rating system for the fifth consecutive year. The Superior Achievement rating is the state’s highest financial ranking, demonstrating the quality of LISD’s fiscal management and reporting system.

“We are very proud LISD has received this rating for another year,” said Superintendent of Schools Dr. Jerry Roy. “This further proves LISD continually strives to make the most of every tax dollar received.”

This rating is one of many awards the district’s Finance and Budgeting departments continually receive for their work. More importantly, LISD is the only school district in Texas to receive the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting by the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA), the Certificate of Excellence in Financial Reporting from the Association of School Business Officials (ASBO), the Distinguished Budget Presentation award by the GFOA, the Meritorious Budget Award by the ASBO and the Pinnacle award for Outstanding Achievement by the ASBO.

Additionally, LISD is the only school district in Texas to receive the Achievement in Excellence in Procurement award from the Institute for Supply Management and National Institute of Governmental Purchasing.

As required by law, the district held a public meeting on Aug. 25 to discuss LISD’s financial accountability rating.
