MINUTES

On Wednesday, October 25, 2006, the Curriculum Council met and was called to order by moderator, Mr. Dennis Winborn. Voting members in attendance were 71.

- I. New Business – Dr. Harry Crenshaw
Ready, Set, Teach! I & II – *Action Item*
Motion was made to submit Ready, Set, Teach! I & II Innovative Course Application to the School Board for their approval. This is a field-based internship which provides students a background knowledge of child and adolescent development principles as well as principles of effective teaching practices.

Committee voted unanimously to submit to the School Board.

- II. Old Business – Kevin Rogers
2007 – 2008 District Calendar – *Action Item*
The Calendar Committee made up of elementary, middle school and high school principals as well as teachers and PTA members unanimously presented their proposed calendar to the Curriculum Council.

Mr. Rogers went through the calendar month by month giving a detailed description of the 2007 – 2008 district calendar.

The Legislature states that Texas School Districts shall not start classes before the 4th Monday of August. Therefore, the first day of class for students would be August 27, 2007.

Basically, the only differences between this calendar and the 2006-2007 calendar will be the addition of Columbus Day/Fair Day, October 8th and the combining of Spring Break with the Easter holidays in March 2008.

The last day of school for students will be June 5, 2008.

Motion was made to accept this calendar, council vote was unanimous. Calendar will be presented at the PTA Board meeting and PTA District Council meeting for their review.

Mr. Rogers will present to the School Board for its approval at the November board meeting.
