

Dear Parents,

Your student's safety is of the utmost importance to the Camey staff. It is important that we know who is entering the building at all times. Sometimes, it becomes a little hectic at the front doors with visitors coming and going and students and staff entering at the same time.

It is very appropriate for parents to ensure that their children know the locations of their waiting areas, classrooms, etc. Parents are asked to allow their children to follow the procedures and find their destinations on their own (with staff supervision) after the first week of school. This will assist with the safety of our students as well as encourage student independence.

During the first week of school, parents may walk students to their classrooms at 7:50 a.m. to assist with carrying supplies and adjusting to the new grade or school. Beginning the second week of school (August 31, 2009) students should be independent in going to their classrooms. School staff will be on duty in the halls to assist new and younger students should the need arise.
