This is Cyber Safety Week and Forestwood would like to remind you of a few online tips to remember: Even when you delete information off of a site, that information can still be retrieved. Someone may have downloaded the content while it was posted, and there are several ways that information on the internet is preserved after it is deleted by the creator. Many social networking site companies keep a copy of a profile to make it easy for you to rejoin the network in the future. Search engines archive, or keep copies of, old Web pages as well as current ones. A nonprofit organization called Internet Archive is dedicated to preserving historic Internet records in an electronic Library and has its own search tool, called the Wayback Machine, that allows users to find and view old versions of Web pages, software videos, and audio files. Remember to be safe when you surf!
