

Greetings Parents/Guardians:

Our yearly field trips are scheduled for Friday, May 6, 2005. Each grade level has made arrangements for students to visit a venue that is of educational value. Every student has the opportunity to go and participate in this educational experience; however, this year the following guidelines are being implemented. This is a component of the Griffin Success Initiative, as outlined in our original proposal.

A campus Field Trip Committee was established to discuss, develop, and review guidelines in which students would follow. The Field Trip Committee consists of teachers and parents working for the good of all students. Before moving forward with these guidelines, they had to be reviewed and approved by Central Administration; approval was granted.

The following are the guidelines, which allow each student the opportunity to make the choice as to whether or not they participate May 6, 2005. Implementation and adherence to these guidelines will begin Monday, March 14, 2005; previously assigned discipline will not be a part of this process. The evaluation period is six-weeks long, March 14 - May 5, 2005. Students and parents will be notified immediately of non participation.

Field Trip Guidelines 2004 -2005
Spring Field Trips

Any student receiving discipline that results in any of the following actions will not be allowed to participate in their grade level field trip.

1. 2 detentions
2. 1 TNS
3. Accumulation of 5 days of lunch PAS
4. Any assignment to PAS, OSS, DAEP, DJJAEP
5. Two or more outstanding zeros in any class

Students remaining on campus will be given an assignment comparable to that of those attending the field trip.

It is our sincere hope that every student will have the opportunity to attend and participate in this experience. All students start with a clear slate Monday, March 14; it is up to them as to whether or not appropriate choices are made and participation permitted.
