

Dear Parents,

As we begin another great year at Highland Village Elementary, I would like to tell you about our fundraising efforts through Corporate Incentives. These are fundraisers where we raise money through your donations. The good news is that your donations are things you already have in your household—product labels, UPC codes, or old cell phones and printer cartridges. This packet is designed to give you all the tools you need to help us out. Last year we raised over **\$3000** on these programs alone.

We have two ongoing collection programs this year - Label Collection and Recycling.

Label Collections include:

-Box Tops for Education - Clip and save Box Tops from participating products. Turn them in and the school gets 10 cents for each box top we redeem. Set up a free account at www.btfe.com to get coupons, enter sweepstakes, get participating lists, and check our school's progress.

-Community Coffee Cash for Schools - Clip and save UPC codes and Cash for Schools coupons from Community Coffee products. Turn them in and the school gets 15 to 75 cents for each label we turn in. Go to www.communitycoffee.com and click Cash for Schools to see the products summary list.

-Labels for Education - Clip and save coupons, UPC codes, bottle caps from specially marked products. Turn them in and the school receives points towards the purchase of school equipment. Go to www.labelsforeducation.com for participating products list.

Recycling Collections include:

-Funding Factory - Turn in your used cell phones and printer cartridges and the school receives cash for cartridges and cell phones redeemed. Collection box is located next to the Homework Hamsters.

-Terracycle - Drink Pouch, Cookie Wrapper and Energy Bar brigades—turn in your empty Capri Sun drink pouches, Nabisco Cookie packets (any size) and energy bar wrappers (any foil lined brand) and HVE gets 2 cents for each one redeemed. Collection bin is located in the cafeteria.

We will provide a ziplock bag and collection sheets to send labels/UPCS in. We will send the ziplock back for reuse. Instructions are on the card in the ziplock bag.

If you have more than one child in the school, you can turn them in all together. Just make sure you have all children's names, grades and teacher's names filled out on the card so we can split them evenly.
