

Phone Message to Parents 10/23/2009

Hello Husky Parents,

This is James Hill, principal of Huffines. Today is the end of the 3 weeks so you should expect to see your child's progress report next Tuesday. Next week is also Red Ribbon week. We are asking all of our students to pledge to be drug free. We are going to have some give aways for those students who make the pledge. We are also having some dress up days to get students excited about Red Ribbon week. Monday's theme is "Follow Your Dreams – Don't do drugs" we are letting students wear their pajama bottoms that day. However, they must not have holes in them or be see-through and must be school appropriate. Also, we are asking that they not wear pajama shorts, tops, or house shoes.
