AVID Overview



- **AVID** (Advancement Via Individual Determination) is an *elective* class that prepares students for four-year colleges and universities.
- **AVID** students are the “academic middle” - B, C or D students who could be an “A” student with additional skills and support in reading, writing and organizational skills
- **AVID** also builds relationships, trust and confidence with class building exercises and activities that are fun!
- An **AVID** class becomes a ‘family’ - sharing goals, celebrating successes and supporting one another through tough and unsure moments
- Must exemplify good behavior and class attendance, and an average of 75 or higher.
- Acceptance into **AVID** requires recommendation, application and interview.

Technology Applications (6th, 7th, 8th)



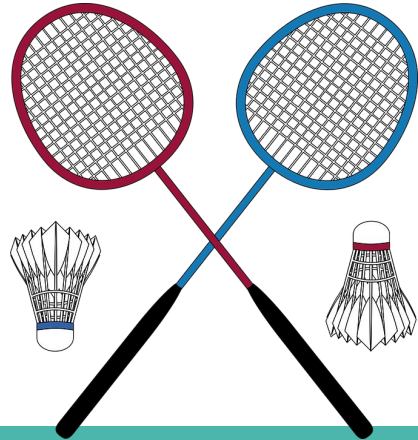
Course Description/Objectives

You are required to dress out in maroon shorts and a gray shirt which you will need to purchase. You can either purchase the ones we have for sale or buy your own from whatever store you would like too.



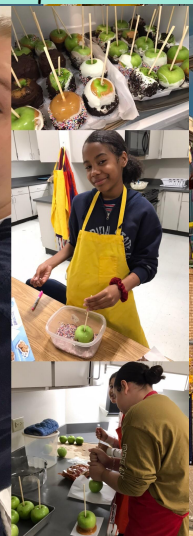
