Parent Access to EOC Scores on the TEA Portal

- Log into the <u>web version</u> of <u>Skyward Family Access</u> by clicking the Skyward icon at the top of <u>LISD.net</u>.
- 2. Select the Educational Milestones Option on the left side of the screen. See image for help.

- Click on the bubble next to test portal access code and write down your student's personal access code. It is a 6-digit code consisting of letters and numbers. See image for help.
