## Eligibility for FAFSA & TAFSA

*(Students may qualify for either the FAFSA or TAFSA)*

### Eligible for the FAFSA

#### **(Free Application for Federal Student Aid)**

- U.S. Citizen
- U.S. National
- Permanent Resident (Green Card Holder)
- Refugee or asylum granted
- Cuban-Haitian Entrant
- T visa holder or child of a T1 visa

### Eligible for the TAFSA

#### **(Texas Application for Federal Student Aid)**

- DACA Student
- Child of work visa holder
- Immigrant Texas student
  - At least three years in Texas
  - Graduated from a Texas high school

## Documents Needed

### Documents to bring:

- Social Security number or an Alien Registration Number
- Driver's License Number (if you have one)
- 2019 Federal Income Tax Return, W-2's, and other records of money earned
- Information on untaxed income (ie...child support)
- List of schools being considered

### Documents to bring:

- Social Security number or DACA number
- Tax transcript
- University ID number
- 2019 Federal Income Tax Return, W-2's, and other records of money earned
- Information on untaxed income
- List of schools being considered

## FSA ID

### Create your FSA ID at:

<https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch>

1. Students and parents need a separate FSA ID
2. The FSA ID is used to log in to your FAFSA, retrieve data using the IRS tool and to sign your FAFSA.
3. To create your FSA ID you will need a social security number and your own mobile phone number and/or email address.
