Dress Code Reminders...

- Students are responsible for picking up deliveries that are left for them. We do not call students out of class.

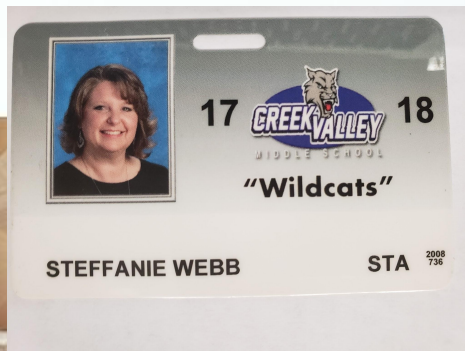
Safety Concerns...



- New entrance procedures!
- Students will always be notified **BEFORE** a drill takes place.
- Parents and families will also be notified via campus social media immediately **AFTER** the drill has taken place.
- Students should not use cell phones during any drill for security purposes.

Student IDs...

- ID and lanyard will be issued to all students during Wildcat Camp
- Must be worn at all times by staff and students
- Lost IDs: replacement cost is \$3.00
- Students that repeatedly do not have their ID will receive disciplinary consequences.



Lunch procedures...

- Students will be assigned either A or B lunch on 8 period days.
- On block days we will have Hour Block Lunch (HBL). Students will choose a club to attend for 6 weeks at a time. They will eat the lunch that is opposite their club time.
- If a student is failing a class or is missing assignments, they will be assigned to mandatory tutorials during their club time.

Grading guidelines...

- 9 week grading periods
- Progress reports each 3-week period; report cards each 9-week period

- Skylert messages will be sent weekly containing weekly updates

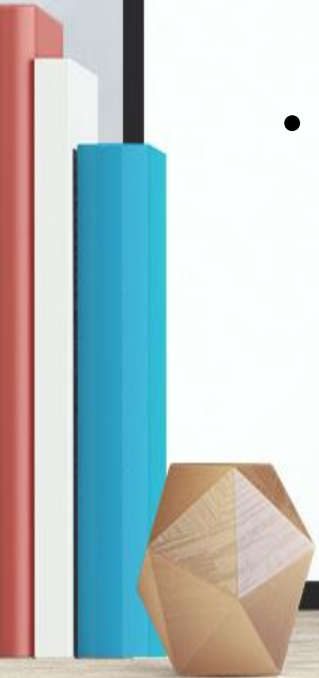


Skyward Family Access...

- Online forms have replaced back to school paperwork.
- Please complete online prior to the first day of school.
- Will carry over from year to year! Makes it much easier on you.
- Contact the school if you are unable to access.
- The library is available today for online forms.
- Be sure to update Emergency Contacts List to improve safety for your student.

PE uniforms...

- P.E. uniforms should consist of plain blue or black shorts with no markings and a gray shirt with no markings OR any CVMS spirit wear shirt.
- Coaches have and will communicate attire expectations for athletics.



7th grade vaccinations...

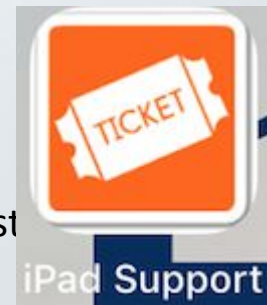
- Must be documented and complete by first day of school.
- Will not be allowed to attend school without the appropriate vaccinations and documentation.
- Contact Esther Lee, school nurse, with questions.

Technology...

- Students are expected to bring LISD issued iPads fully charged every day.
- Students may bring personal technology - cell phones, iPads, tablets, etc.
- Both district, school, and personal technology must adhere to the district's AUP policy.
- Teachers can ask the student to put away their technology and/or put it in a safe/secure location until the end of class.
- Students may not use their phones to take pictures in the restrooms or locker rooms (Texas Penal Code 21.15)



New Information for iPads

- \$40 annual Insurance Benefit Program fee
- **1st Break or Loss:** No Charge
- **2nd Break:** \$50 Co-Pay
- **3rd Break:** Full Cost of iPad \$399
 - After a 2nd or 3rd Break the order for the replacement iPad will not be sent until the fee is paid in full
 - With each break students and parents must complete the Device Repair Notification Form and turn it into the office before the order for repair is completed
- Smart Keyboard Replacement Costs:
 - \$40 Co-pay 1st break or loss of new smart keyboard only
 - \$100 Co-pay 2nd break or loss of new smart keyboard
 - \$110 full replacement cost for 3rd break replacement cost
- Keyboards MUST be on at all times

New Information for iPads

- October 1st & 2nd iPad Refresh
 - 7th and 8th Grade will receive updated iPad and keyboard
 - 6th Grade received their updated iPad and keyboard last year
- In order to refresh students must have:
 - District issued iPad
 - District issued cord
 - iPad **MUST** be fixed and in good working condition

Arrival to school...

- Building opens at 7:45 am for students.
- Office opens at 8:15 am for everyone else.
- No students will be allowed in the halls for tutorials until 8:20 am
- Students report to cafeteria, gym or teacher tutorials.
- Bell releases to class at 8:47 am
- School begins at 8:55 am

Dismissal procedures...

- School is released at 4:10 pm
- Bus riders report to their assigned table in cafeteria/gym to be released to their bus.
- Students walking home should exit through the front and leave campus upon dismissal. They may not re-enter the building.
- Students being picked up should meet their rides at the carpool lane. Car riders may not cross the street.
- For safety during dismissal, traffic behind the school is reserved for bus traffic only.
- By 4:20pm students should be off-campus or at a supervised activity.

Traffic flow in parking lots...

- Drop Off: enter & turn right following the single drop off lane.
- Pick - Up traffic enter the same route.
- Staff members direct traffic after school
- Please pull up to the turn out to wait for your student.
- Please do not block the bus pick up lane or the parking lot exit.
- Students are not allowed to cross the street to be picked up by parents and must cross at the corner if walking.

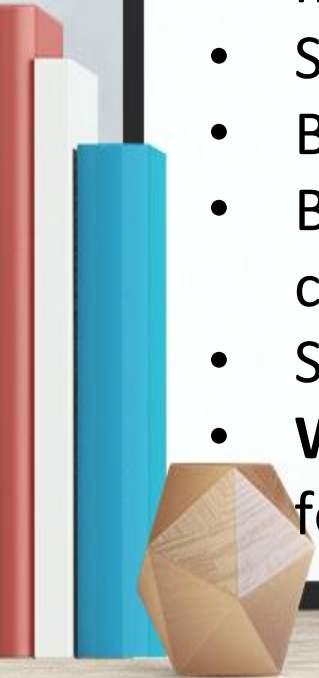


Student schedules...

- Today's schedules are temporary. Classes continue to be balanced and your child's schedule could change.
- Schedule change requests can be picked up and returned today for mistakes or missing classes.
- Schedules will go live in Skyward next Thursday, August 8th.

First Day of School...

- Building opens at 7:45 am to students.
- Students will report to their Advisory Teacher that is listed on their schedules when the bell rings.
- Final schedule passed out – will be different color; must take final schedule to classes.
- School starts at 8:55 am
- Backpacks are fine.
- Back to School Forms on Skyward should be completed prior to the first day.
- School supplies can be brought on first day.
- **Wildcat Camp** is the 1st two days of school. We will follow the regular school schedule afterwards.



Feel free to walk the building to locate classes on your temporary schedule. Just keep in mind that this could change before the first day of school.

As you walk the building, please remain in hallways and/or common areas, keeping out of classrooms.
