ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL

- Building opens at 7:45 AM
 - Students report to cafeteria and sit
 - Students will be allowed in the halls for tutorials at 8:25
 AM
 - Bell releases to class at 8:50 AM
- School begins at 8:55 AM
- School is released at 4:10 PM
 - Bus riders report to assigned section in cafeteria
 - Students walking home exit through the front and leave campus
 - Car riders meet their rides at the front of the school
 - For safety during dismissal, traffic behind the school is reserved for bus traffic only
- By 4:30 PM students should be off-campus or at a supervised activity.

TRAFFIC FLOW

- There are two lanes in the driveways.
- Students should only be dropped off from parking areas or right lane of driveway.
- Students and visitors should use marked crosswalk from parking areas.
- Left lane of driveway is for traffic flow—no dropping off students from left lane.
- Left lane of driveway turns left out of parking lot; right lane can go straight or turn right. Going straight is an alternate route back to North Colony Boulevard.

DRESS CODE

Primary goals are safety & security and reducing classroom distraction or disruption.
