Background

September 16-25: Survey provided to families and teachers who are in the virtual learning pathway.

- There were 11,356 responses to the family survey and 940 responses to the teacher survey.
- The total enrollment for students in the virtual and virtual plus pathway is 21,765.
- Therefore, the survey responses represent 52% of the virtual enrollment.
- Parents/Guardians were asked to complete a separate survey for each child enrolled.






