

6th Annual FUN RUN at the Lake

This is when the real fun begins!

Are you new to Ethridge? Is this your first Fun Run? Our annual Fun Run is a great morning at the Stewart Creek Peninsula Lake where students run a designated track to see how many laps they can do. Each time they complete a lap they receive a check in the box on the back of their shirt that becomes their “Badge of Honor” so to speak. Students wear their t-shirts proudly the rest of the year!

Parents, you are welcome to check in at the office, get a printed badge, and then accompany your child’s class to the lake.

Here’s how it works: The day starts off in our cafeteria with a short pep rally and then we all head to the lake following behind the fire truck. The police see to our safety as we fill the roadway with a sea of purple shirts! Once we all arrive at the lake, the run begins. Everyone runs at the same time on two separate tracks, one for kinder, 1st and 2nd graders, and another for 3rd 4th and 5th graders. The firemen help us out by checking off the boxes on the student’s shirts. It’s great to see families and friends line the tracks and come to cheer the students as they try to finish just one more lap. The entrance to the lake will be closed to vehicles, so plan to wear you walking shoes!!

But wait, we’re not done yet.....after all that running, you must be hungry so join your child back at the school for hot dogs and hamburgers! Lunch times may vary due to the ending of our run, so be ready to be flexible! (Lunch prices apply as normal).
