



Ready to get started? Everything you need to know to participate in the LISD Video Library Challenge is provided below.

From now until Jan. 26, 2018, teachers can submit videos that demonstrates one of the following instructional strategies:

- Accommodations
- Classroom Management/Learning Environment
- Co-Teaching Environment
- Cooperative Learning
- Critical Thinking
- Design Qualities
- Differentiated Instruction
- Empowering Students/Student Ownership
- Engagement
- Formative Assessment
- Giving & Receiving Feedback
- Guided Math
- Guided Reading

We are looking for a 4-6 minute video that demonstrates successful implementation of the above-mentioned strategies.

The LISD Professional Learning Library will be used by teachers, instructional coaches, and administrators across LISD. The videos will be securely held in an LISD Vimeo library account, and only available to LISD educators.

You may submit as many videos as you'd like. Your name will be added to each prize drawing with each video submission, so the more you submit, the better chances you'll have of winning! You will only be eligible to receive a maximum of 1 hour SBEC/Nov. Trade Credit.

How Do I earn SBEC/Nov. Trade Credit?

When you submit your video, you will have the opportunity to answer three reflection questions. You will need to complete all of the reflection questions in order to receive the SBEC/Nov. Trade Credit. Your credit will appear in your Eduphoria portfolio by the end of January, 2018.

Follow the **3 steps** below to submit your video.

Step 1: Preparation

Prior to making your recording, be sure to check the following:


- Your camera is working and focused on the intended person (people)
- Your microphone (can be included on device) is working and the audio is at an acceptable level

Step 2: Record your video

1. Record your video - It is best to record in landscape mode.

Step 3: Name your video, Upload and Share your video

1. Upload your video to your @staff.lisd.net Google account.



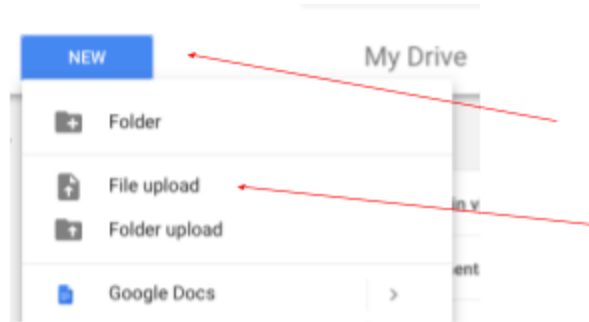

1. Click on your name
2. Check to make sure you are logged in to your @staff.lisd.net account

2. Upload your video from your camera roll



Select your video file from your camera roll or where you saved the video.

3. Title your video with the name of the content-specific topic or teaching strategy followed by your last name. Examples: Critical Thinking - Brown, Guided Reading - Ridinger, Differentiated Instruction - Kixmiller



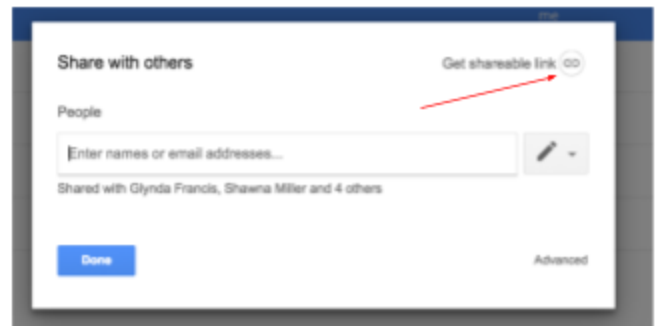
1. Select your video
2. Click on the 3 dots
3. Select Rename...

4. Set the Sharing Permissions to anyone at LISD with the link can view

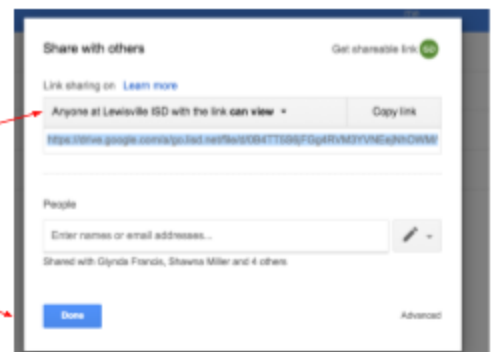
1. Select your video
2. Click the share icon
3. The box below will appear



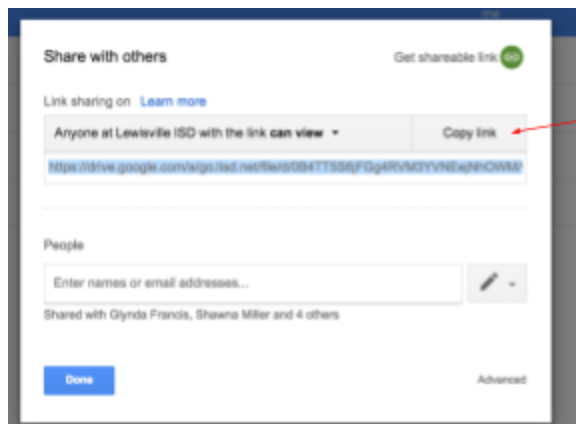
4. Click the link icon
5. After you click the link, the box below will appear



6. The sharing permissions will be changed to Anyone at Lewisville ISD with the link can view
7. Click Done



5. Copy the shareable link to your video.
