## Important Professional Learning Information

### Staff Professional Learning Days

The professional learning days in August do not require waivers from the state; therefore we have a little more flexibility. Any teambuilding activities or outings need to occur in August, with approval by your assistant chief. \*Please ensure that social media postings reflect the hard work that teachers engage in to prepare for school starting.

The October embedded professional learning day is tied to a state waiver. The schedule and content of the day must include 6 hours of professional learning as defined in the chart.

### Early Release Days

There are 3 student early release days on the calendar, October, March, and May. Due to the placement of the early release days on this year's calendar, all three days will be work days. All staff is expected to work the full day and leave at the end of their regular contract day. \*Early release days will be reviewed and analyzed each year for usage and intent.

### November Trade Credit Requests

All requests for learning to count towards November trade credit must align with the professional learning defined in the chart and meet trade credit requirements of occurring outside of contract days/hours.
