ELEMENTARY LEARNING SESSIONS

Welcome to Summer Learning in LISD! The information provided in this document will give you an overview of the Elementary August Trade Day courses available for teachers during the summer months. LISD August Trade Credit is earned in order to gain professional learning related to content specific curriculum. Professional staff who complete the August credit requirement during the summer may stay home on Monday, August 5th. All teachers of record for K-5 Language Arts must get their 6 hours of Aug. Trade Credit from Language Arts New TEKS and New Resources sessions.

Here are some important points to keep in mind:

- NEW TEKS IN LANGUAGE ARTS THIS SUMMER! All teachers of record for Language Arts will be REQUIRED to complete 2 sessions for a total of 6 hours in order to implement NEW TEKS AND NEW MATERIALS. See table below.
- All summer courses open on Mon., April 15th at 7 a.m. Most elementary courses will be held at LHS.
- **Eduphoria** is the main website to search and register for any courses not included in this flyer including special education, fine arts, and any other specialized teaching assignment.
- Most courses have a maximum capacity of 30 participants. Any sessions with less than 10 attendees will be cancelled.
- If you are not able to attend a trade session, you are required to attend the official elementary teacher trade day on Monday, August 5 found [here](#).
- There is NO half day session on the August 5th official August Trade Day. Teachers either need to attend all 6 hours in the summer or all day on August 5th.
- Any courses you attend that exceed 6 hours of August Trade Credit will automatically roll over to count towards November Trade Credit by the Professional Learning Department in October.
- Children of employees are NOT allowed to remain on site during sessions.
