Admission requirements are strict:

- An overall unweighted GPA of 3.3
- A grade requirement of 90 for Regular level English
- Or, a grade requirement of 85 for Pre-AP/AP/Dual Credit English
- A desire to become involved and participate actively in this organization
- Pay annual membership fees to cover operating costs and national dues

To remain a member in good standing, students must earn a total of 30 service points per school year. Points opportunities are varied and may include service activities, literacy events, meeting attendance, and much more. There are multiple ways to earn points throughout the school year.

The annual membership drive takes place during the month of August through the first week of September.
