- 1. You must be a student in high school who plans to graduate in 2025.
- 2. You must live in The Town of Flower Mound. However, if you live in Flower Mound, you may go to school outside of Flower Mound.
- 3. You must write an essay of no more than 250 words, entitled, "Why Seniors (Age 50 and beyond) Are Important and needed for balance of the Community of Flower Mound."

- 4. Please put your last name and last four digits of social ½ inch from the top of each page in left margin (MLA style). Center the title and type it 1 inch from the top of page 1. (See Scoring sheet for qualities to be judged on writing.)
- 5. You must submit a resume which includes your academic skills, leadership abilities, honors, accomplishments, extracurricular activities, service activities, and any other important information that will reveal who you are. (See scoring sheet for what information will be taken from resume.)
- 6. Include two letters of recommendation, which refer to your academic skills, leadership ability, honors, accomplishments, and personality traits. One letter should be written by a teacher and another should be written by someone else involved in your life.
- 7. Go to the Scoring Sheet and read it completely. This page will be read by evaluators, and the evaluations combined for the final score.
- 8. Attach Information and Requirements page and Scoring Sheet to essay, resume, and letters of recommendation in aforementioned order. Sign below when you finish, showing you have read all of the directions.
- 9. This application should be postmarked or hand delivered no later than 4:30 p.m., May 1, 2026.
