IDS AND SCHEDULES

Student IDs

Student IDs are part of the LISD student dress code and must be worn at all times. Students who attended LISD last year will pick up a copy of last year's ID and a new lanyard during orientation. Lanyards will be provided to all students. Students who did not attend Hebron/LISD last year will need to get a temporary ID made in the library the first week of school. New IDs will be distributed once all students have taken their 2022-23 school pictures.

Student Schedules

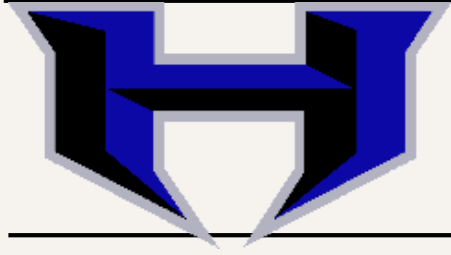
The HHS Counseling Department is still working on completing the master schedule. Student schedules are not yet finalized and a date for their Skyward release is still being determined.

Please remember that requests to change classes for the upcoming school year are not being accepted. All changes were due by the last day of school in May 2022 after multiple opportunities to select courses, meet with counselors, and review options. HHS Counselors are using any and all alternate choices submitted by students to fix schedule issues where possible.

Due to an overall staffing shortage in a couple of critical areas, HHS will not be able to offer AP Computer Science, Computer Science 3, Robotics 1 and Robotics 2 for the 2022-2023 school year. Counselors are using alternate course requests submitted by students to fix courses requests as student schedules are finalized.

PARKING

Senior Parking

Seniors have three parking options - General for \$5, reserved for \$25, or painted spaces for \$100. There are two steps; you first must complete the form before orientation for the type of spot you would like; second, you must pay in RevTrac (on the HHS website, under online payments, under the resources tab). Once you have paid, you will pick up your sticker at orientation. Please note that parking spaces are limited. There are only 80 painted and 284 reserved, and they are first come, first served.

SENIOR parking opened July 1st and will run until July 20th.

Sophomore/Junior Parking

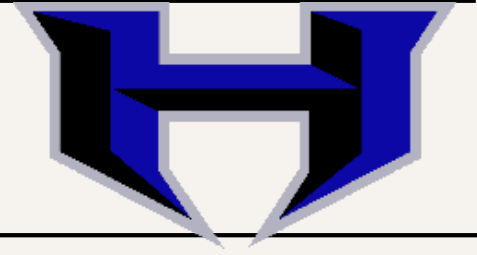
Sophomores & Juniors will be able to start purchasing parking on July 20th.
