General Information

Please register in Canvas or Eduphoria for Secondary G/T courses. Sessions will be offered in the fall, spring, and summer months.

All out of district G/T credit requests must be submitted through Eduphoria STRIVE including documentation of completion. Once approved by Advanced Academics, credit will post to individual portfolios. **Only submit current year documents through Eduphoria STRIVE.** Be sure to request the credit category needed: **“Initial G/T Credit”** or **“G/T Update Credit.”**

Educators with previous (outside of district) documentation demonstrating completion of the 30-hour initial G/T training may submit your certificates through STRIVE. Once reviewed and approved, your transfer credit will be posted on your Eduphoria STRIVE portfolio. If you cannot produce documentation of initial series completion, we require that you renew your training to remain current with best practices in gifted education.
