**The Catch** program to address vaping has been previously viewed, members received an update and refresh on what this curriculum offers.

Evaluation of Comprehensive Counseling Program-H. DeGroot gave a recap of last year's goals for the sub-committee and reviewed the app Rhithm and the current practices in place to assist students with future pathways.
