RESTROOM PROCEDURES Hicks Elementary

Expectations for Student Behavior:

- The outside restroom doors will remain cracked open during school hours.
- There should never be more students in a restroom than facilities available. If all facilities are occupied, students are to wait outside the restroom door.
- Students are to leave the restroom as soon as their business is taken care of.
- 4. Students are not to climb the stalls.
- 5. Students are not to crawl under the stalls.
- 6. Students are to use toilet paper for its intended use.
- Students are to ensure that all toilet paper gets flushed.
- 8. Students are not to flush the toilets or urinals more than once.
- 9. Students are not to put any objects in the toilets or urinals.
- 10. If urinals or toilets are not working properly, students are to inform a teacher.
- 11. If the restroom floor is not clean, students are to inform a teacher.
- 12. Students are to keep hands and feet to themselves.
- 13. Students are not to talk while using the facilities.
- 14. Students are not to urinate or defecate anywhere but the toilets or urinals.
- 15. Students are to wash their hands for an appropriate amount of time (ABC song) and return to class
- 16. Students are to pump the soap no more than 2 times.
- 17. Students are to use the dryer for an appropriate amount of time (ABC song) and return to class.
- 18. Students are not to stick their heads under the dryers.
- 19. Students are not to talk while washing/drying hands.
- 20. Students are to get drinks from the water fountain quickly.
- 21. If students are using the restroom without their class, they must have teacher permission.
- 22. If students are using the restroom without their class, they must use the restroom that is closest to them.

Consequences

- Contact the student's teacher
- 2. Assign the student a restroom buddy to monitor
- 3. Students will clean the restroom
- 4. Loss of restroom privileges
- 5. Other consequences will be logical and vary depending on the offense
