Eligible Participants: All Southern Denton County Students in Grades 4 – 12



Requirements: All work must be original and must relate to Dr. King's ideals, philosophy, and principles. The title of your work must be: **Loving the Diversity in Our World.** Art canvas, poster board, or any quality art paper may be used. If using poster board or art paper, it must be matted. Measurements, including the matting, should be a minimum of 9" x12" and maximum of 16" x 20". Art canvas does not need to be matted.

Name, phone, email, grade, school, and teacher's name should be written on the back. Please tape a 3"X5" card with an explanation of your work on the back.

GRAPHICS and GRAPHIC ART may be used for ENHANCEMENT but must comply with copyright laws. If the artwork is 3-D, it must be able to either stand alone or hang on the wall.
