Teachers will select the top 10 per class to send to us.

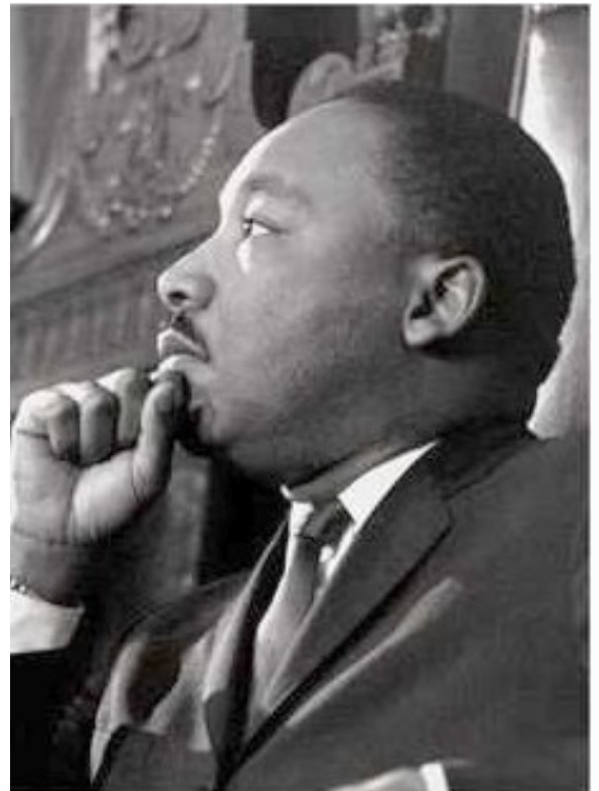
Grades 4-5 – 200-300 Words
