2018-19 ART, ESSAY, and Photography

Theme: Loving the Diversity in Our World

Eligible Participants: All Southern Denton County Students in Grades 4 – 12

ART Requirements:

All work **must** be original and must relate to Dr. King's ideals, philosophy, and principles. The title of your work must be: **Loving the Diversity in Our World**. Art canvas, poster board, or any quality art paper may be used. If using poster board or art paper, it must be matted. Measurements, including the matting, should be a minimum of 9" x12" and maximum of 16" x 20". Art canvas does not need to be matted.

Name, phone, email, grade, school, and teacher's name should be written legibly on the back. Please tape a 3"X5" card with an explanation of your work on the back.

ESSAY Requirements:

All typed essays must be original and relate to Dr. King's ideals, philosophy, and principles. It must also incorporate this year's theme. It should be titled: **Loving the Diversity in Our World**. Full Name, phone, email, grade, school, and teacher's name must be written legibly on a separate cover sheet.

Teachers will select the top 10 per class to send to us.

Grades 4-5 – 200-300 Words Grades 6-8 – 300-500 Words Grades 9-12 – 500-800 Words

PHOTOGRAPHY Requirements:

All entries must relate to Dr. King's ideals, philosophy, and principles. It must be titled: **Loving the Diversity in Our World**. Photos must be original composition, may be film or digital, color or B&W, with minimal retouching, and mounted on poster board. Measurements, including the matting, should be a minimum of 9" x12" and maximum of 16" x 20". Name, phone, email, grade, school, and teacher's name must be written legibly on the back. **Name, phone, email, grade, school, and teacher's name must be written on the back.**

Please tape a 3"X5" card with an explanation of your work on the back.
