

30th Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Contest

2022-2023 Creative Photography

Theme: “Living the Dream: It takes a Team”

Eligible Participants: All Southern Denton County Students in Grades 4-12

Requirements: The Creative Photography entry may be in Color or B&W, digitally enhanced or an unedited photograph. Graphic design or enhancements are allowed only if all components of the entry are original work and not copied from the web or other sources. The title of your work must be this year’s theme which must appear in your work in a manner of your choosing. It should explore the impact of the theme on the daily life of society or your own life. It should also portray Dr. King’s ideals of unity, peace, and harmony. The entry needs to be on a poster board, approx. 16 in X 20 inches. On the back, please affix a 3X5 card. On the card, we need your printed full name (w/phonetic pronunciation), telephone number, email, grade, school, and teacher’s name. You should write the story of the entry on this card. Items such as the circumstances of the photo, its connection to the theme, and the message you wish to send to the viewers/judges need to be included. [Additional rules, below]

4th-5th grade (Elem):
