Most Dual Credit courses will open starting in junior year. So he will wait for Dual Credit until the following year. Both AP and Dual Credit are great options. It does depend on the student and what is best for him. You can reach out to their counselor to talk through what might be best for him. AP and Dual Credit are both weighted the same in class ranking. For college credit with AP courses, you will receive the credit passed on the passing score on the AP test. For Dual Credit, you will receive the credit after passing the course. Colleges look for students to challenge themselves in any areas, whether that is AP or Dual Credit.
