



Lewisville ISD is a leader in Texas and the nation in providing flexible learning opportunities for secondary students.

The LISD Blended ED program gives students agency in designing their personalized learning pathways in **A la Carte** model.

- **Enriched Virtual Blended Courses-High School**
 - Students meet face-to-face on campus three days a week and work online two days a week. Students do not have to be physically present on online days.
 - Students have Flexible Mobility to collaborate with their peers or meet with their teachers during an online day for one-on-one or small group support.
 - Enriched Virtual courses allow for a high level of personalization.
- **Online Courses**
 - Online learning is the backbone of student learning. Students work online at a place and time to be determined by the student. Students do not have to be physically present on campus to take an online course.
 - Online courses are offered through the LISD Virtual Learning Academy and the Texas Virtual School Network.
 - Online students receive personalized attention through campus visits by their online teachers and through real-time learning via synchronous tools like Zoom, Skype, and Google.

How to register: Mid- February using the “Online Forms” button in Skyward

Facts:

- VLA courses require a separate application through student Skyward access.
- There is a fee associated with online courses.
- Online core courses (English, Math, Science, Social Studies, World Languages and AP courses) count toward GPA and Rank in Class with the same multipliers as same courses taken on campus.
- Students/Parents are responsible for completing registration and payment for online courses.

Students completing STAAR EOC courses, Algebra 1, Biology, Eng I, Eng 2 or US History, through VLA, still must take and pass the EOC.
