BlendEd Classes:

- ✓ A “blend” of face to face & online learning
- ✓ Students can work from home on “flex days” & attend class on face to face days
- ✓ Options for flex day study locations
- ✓ Improve study habits & student/teacher communication
- ✓ Offers personalized learning & support
- ✓ Available in a variety of subjects

Grades 9 - 12

Virtual Learning Academy:

- ✓ Online learning for core & electives
- ✓ Promotes time management & being a self-directed student
- ✓ Good summer option to open up schedule during the academic year
- ✓ Available year round (Fall, Spring, & Summer)
- ✓ See vla.lisd.net for course listing
- ✓ Register via Skyward >>Online Forms
- ✓ Requires pre-approval by counselor

Grades 9 - 12

Pre-AP & AP Courses:

- ✓ creates a climate of academically motivated students
- ✓ goes deeper into the TEKS but has same curriculum as regular class
- ✓ may involve more study time outside of class
- ✓ carries a weighted multiplier towards GPA:

AP- Level 3	P/AP- Level 2	Regular- Level 1
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- ✓ consider balance in coursework & other activities when weighing options
- ✓ uses Level-Down guidelines if needed (after 3 weeks or 9 weeks)
- ✓ AP courses offer an AP test at the end of the course for approx \$100 for college credit, depending on student's score

Grades 9 - 12

Dual Credit Courses:

- ✓ earn MHS credit & NCTC college hours simultaneously
- ✓ some courses taught on MHS campus (others at NCTC Parker Square)
- ✓ Recommended 3.0 GPA to enroll
- ✓ Courses available during school year and/or summer
- ✓ Excellent tuition value
- ✓ Grades post to NCTC & LISD transcript
- ✓ Counts as additional multiplier in GPA
- ✓ See counselor to apply & for approved list of courses

Grades 10, 11 & 12

G/T Course Options:

- ✓ for students identified as gifted learners in LISD
- ✓ access to core classes designated solely for G/T students
- ✓ taught by teachers who are highly trained to best meet the unique needs of G/T learners
- ✓ allows G/T students to effectively communicate & collaborate
- ✓ offers atmosphere that promotes creativity & innovation
- ✓ promotes self-awareness & social consciousness
- ✓ encourages scholarly behaviors that discover, develop, & leverage capacity
- ✓ same GPA weights as their respective P/AP or AP course.

LISD Collegiate Academy:

- ✓ earn Associate's degree or up to 60 Dual Credit hours while in high school
- ✓ excellent tuition value
- ✓ located at The Colony HS
- ✓ accepted students receive transfers
- ✓ college coursework provided via Collin College
- ✓ students accepted by application
- ✓ Counts as additional multiplier in GPA
- ✓ Full and half credits courses available
- ✓ see your 8th grade counselor for more info
