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As part of the important safety measures Lewisville ISD is putting in place for this year, all LISD middle schools will use an A/B block schedule. Students attend one set of classes on "A" days and another set of classes on "B" days. A similar A/B block schedule will be followed as we implement remote learning to start the school year.

Allowing for natural social distancing is one of our primary safety considerations for students and staff as we continue responding to COVID-19. This schedule helps us for the following reasons:

- This bell schedule will cut in half the number of times students transition between classes, meaning students will be in hallways less.
- Students and teachers alike will come in contact with fewer people each day, because only half of the classes take place on the A/B block schedule.
- A fourth lunch was added to allow students to spread out more in the cafeteria.
- Passing periods will be staggered so fewer students are in the hallways.
- Students will be assigned a Homeroom which they will be required to report each morning. It is a place for students to eat breakfast and wait to be dismissed to first or second-period class and socially distance before school starts (normally they would go to the cafeteria/bleachers).

We know this is a challenging time for our students and families. It is a challenging time for administrators, teachers, and our campus staff as well! But we will continue working together to ensure ALL our students have the opportunity to be successful, in spite of the circumstances we are all facing.
