



THE FATHER OF THE YEAR SCHOLARSHIP AND SYLVAN LANDAU SCHOLARSHIP OF COMMUNITIES FOUNDATION OF TEXAS

The Father of the Year and Sylvan Landau Scholarships are awarded to students in financial need who have achieved an average degree of academic excellence. The Sylvan Landau scholarship gives preference to students intending to study Business or Marketing, while the Father of the Year Scholarship is open to all majors. These one-year awards provide \$5,000 for tuition, fees and books at any accredited college or university the United States or its possessions, including but not limited to four-year universities and community colleges.

Eligible applicants must be graduating Seniors from a high school in Dallas, Tarrant, Collin or Denton counties in Texas or previous recipients of the Father of the Year or Sylvan Landau Scholarships. Applicants must be in good standing as students and have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale, and either a minimum SAT score of 1500 (if taken January 2016 and earlier), a minimum SAT score of 1090 (if taken March 2016 and after), or ACT score of 22. Applicants must also be U.S. citizens or documented legal residents of the United States.

Two letters of recommendation attesting to an applicant's community participation, demonstrated leadership potential and financial need will be required. All applicants must also complete the FAFSA and submit an essay response to one of three questions.
