THE BROCKMAN SCHOLARSHIP

The Brockman Scholarship is a merit-based full-ride scholarship that covers five years of study on the College Station campus of Texas A&M. The scholarship supports four years of undergraduate study in an approved STEM (science, technology, engineering, mathematics) program, as well as the one-year Master of Science in Business graduate degree program for non-business majors at Texas A&M's Mays Business School.

Tuition is covered in full (for both in-state and out-of-state students), along with room and board, transportation, books and supplies and at least one credit-bearing, university-organized overseas study opportunity. Scholars are also afforded unique opportunities to enhance their personal, academic and professional development through the Brockman Scholars Program. Additional support is granted to members of the Corps of Cadets. Please see our website for more information.

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered, you must:

- Be an American citizen resident anywhere in the world. International (non-U.S. citizen) students may apply if they can obtain a visa to study in the U.S.
- Have applied to an approved program of study at Texas A&M University.
- Score at least 1400 on the SAT or 32 on the ACT. *The BSP has moved to a test-optional application policy for the 2021 intake due to COVID-19. Please see the Brockman Scholars Program website for more information.
- Commit to pursuing an undergraduate degree in a STEM field and the one-year MS Business graduate program for nonbusiness majors.
- Be under 21 at the date of application for the scholarship.
- Not have previously been a full-time university/college student.
- Not be related to a sitting member of the Texas A&M University Board of Regents.
- Demonstrate excellence in academics, leadership and constructive social engagement.
