For the past five summers I have hosted a workshop for rising seniors to work on their college essays used for the college application process and scholarship opportunities. The workshop is four (4) days long for three (3) hours each day. Join us as we learn essay writing strategies, discuss common pitfalls to avoid, and start writing. Students will receive individual feedback via writing conferences and will finish the workshop with 1-2 complete (or nearly complete) personal essays. Due to the nature of the process, we are limiting ten (10) students per session. Sessions will be offered throughout the summer at different times to accommodate your different schedules. As sessions fill up, I may add more sessions.
