Dual Credit TSI Eligibility

All Dual Credit students must demonstrate college readiness by achieving minimum passing standards on relevant sections of an approved assessment instrument. The chart below indicates the assessment and the passing standards as approved by THECB. (revised July 2017)

STAAR/EOC	English II -4000 Algebra I – 4000 and completion of Alg. 2 with a passing grade		2000 on Reading AND 2000 on Writing or 4000 if score is combined
PSAT/MNSQT	No Composite	Math -510 Reading/Writing - 460 (EBRW)	
PLAN Aspire	Not accepting due to Scores pending THECB approval		

- **College level Math**—Students must score college level on the **Math portion** of tests in order to take a college level Math course.
- **College level English**—Students must score college level on the **Reading and Writing portion** of tests in order to take English Composition. (*effective all new applicants Fall 2018*)
- **College level Reading** —Students must score college level on **Reading portion** of tests in order to take **ANY OTHER** college level courses

Check with High School Counselor to determine if TSI Testing is available at your high school. If not contact the NCTC Testing Center to schedule a TSI Assessment (given only on specific days).
