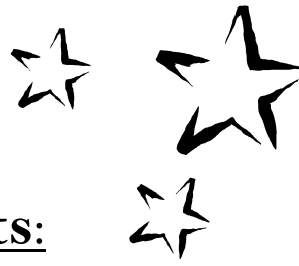

**FMHS Theatre Facts:**



### Theatre Arts I

Any student may register for **Theatre Arts I** (*This will satisfy your Fine Arts credit*). This is a 18-week course covering all aspects of theatre arts including theatre games, pantomime, general acting techniques, technical theatre and improvisation. A great way to begin working in the FMHS Theatre Department!

**Note:** *Because of the popularity of Theatre II, it is suggested that you sign up for Theatre II along with Theatre I.*

### Technical Theatre I

Any student may register for **Technical Theatre I** (*This will satisfy your Fine Arts credit*). This is an 18-week course covering all aspects of technical theatre. Students will be required to learn the basic techniques of the scene and costume shop as well as the working stage. Students will also learn and apply the functions of shop and costume tools. All students are required to serve 3 hours outside of class building scenery for an FMHS production.

### Technical Theatre I (Costume Design)

This 18 week class (*This will satisfy the Fine Arts credit*) emphasizes costume design and construction. Students enrolled in Costume Design will learn to sew from a pattern and will be responsible for creating costumes for one of the FMHS theatre department's play productions during the course of the semester. A 3 hour work call session outside of school is required.

### Theatre Arts II

Students who successfully pass **Theatre Arts I** and receive teacher approval through an in-class audition may sign up for **Theatre Arts II**. This is an 18-week continuation in the basic studies of Theatre Arts. Students in this class will have their first public performance to help prepare them for upper level classes.

### Technical Theatre II

Students who successfully pass **Technical Theatre I** may sign up for **Technical Theatre II**. This is an 18-week continuation in the basic studies of Technical Theatre. Students will continue their knowledge of the scene and costume shop to assist in the design and building of FMHS productions. All students are required to serve 3 hours outside of class building scenery for an FMHS production.

### Theatre III/IV & Production I-IV (NP)

These are 18-week courses designed as an intensified monologue and scene study. Students will work on their skills through work on contemporary, Shakespeare and children's theatre scripts. Students must have successfully completed **Theatre I and II** and have teacher approval.

### Theatre III/IV (Paw 'Prents) & Theatre Production I – IV (Dramatic Paws)

You must audition to enroll in **Theatre III, IV** and **Theatre Production I, II, III, IV**. Auditions will be in May and you must have completed **Theatre Arts I**. See a theatre teacher for more information.

### Tech Theatre II/Advanced Technical Theatre Classes (Tech II, III, IV)

Tech Theatre II is available in the Spring to anyone who successfully completes Tech Theatre I and has teacher approval. *Advanced Technical Theatre* classes are available to those who have successfully completed **Theatre Arts I** or **Technical Theatre I**. However, you must interview. Interviews are held in May. See a theatre teacher for more information.
