



## Dual Credit TSI Eligibility

**All Dual Credit students must demonstrate college readiness by achieving minimum passing standards on relevant sections of an approved assessment instrument. The chart below indicates the assessment and the passing standards as approved by THECB. (revised July 2017 )**

<b>ACT</b>	23 composite	19 - Math 19 – English	5 years from date of test
<b>NEW SAT</b>	No composite score	530 – Math 480 – Reading & Writing (EBRW)	5 years from date of test
<b>STAAR/EOC</b>	English II -4000 (taken during 10 <sup>th</sup> grade year) Algebra II – 4000 (taken during 11 <sup>th</sup> grade)		2000 on Reading AND 2000 on Writing or 4000 if score is combined
<b>PSAT/MNSQT</b>	Not accepting due to Scores pending THECB approval		
<b>PLAN Aspire</b>	Not accepting due to Scores pending THECB approval		

- **College level Math**—Students must score college level on the **Math portion** of tests in order to take a college level Math course.
- **College level English**—Students must score college level on the **Reading and Writing portion** of tests in order to take English Composition. (*effective all new applicants Fall 2018*)
- **College level Reading** —Students must score college level on **Reading portion** of tests in order to take **ANY OTHER** college level courses
