Overview of Digital Resources for Our Class

Digital Resource: Pearson Realize - Digits

Overview: Pearson Realize Digits is a complete digital resource for students. By clicking on the "Programs" prompt, students can re-play lesson presentations including examples. When students click on the red "Classes" prompt, students can open new assignments, continue working on assignments already started and review completed assignments. The online assignment offers two types of help and allows students to check their answers three times before submitting an answer. Students may also complete each assignment twice for a higher grade.

Use at Home: Students will use Pearson Realize – Digits in two ways. First, if a student was absent or unable to attend tutorials, the student can review the concept presentation. Second, the student can complete independent practice (homework assignments) while still receiving multiple levels of support.
