Using Digital Resources at Home

Dear **Durham** Parent,

Our year is off to a great start! It is time to begin homework assignments using our digital resources. Here is a brief overview of what you can expect for digital homework and approximately how long it should take to complete. If your child is spending more than **30-45** minutes for regular math / 45 minutes – 1 hour for Algebra I on homework for my class, please contact me so that we can identify any issues together.

Expectations for Digital Homework at Home

Digital Resource: *Pearson Realize - Digits*

Homework Expectations: *Homework may be assign daily. Usually the homework has been modified to reduce the number of questions. Students are expected to check their answers before submitting the assignment. Students are expected to complete the assignment before the next class. Students are expected to receive a grade of 70 or higher on the assignment. If they receive a lower grade, they are expected to retake the lesson (1 time) or attend tutorials. Any student may retake a homework assignment for a higher grade 1 time, but should be done before the due date.*

Approximate Completion Time: *30 – 45 minutes for regular math, 45-60 minutes pre-AP or Algebra*

Backup Plan

Digital resources are only a part of our work in class and at home. If your child has any issues with completing their digital work at home, please know that I have a backup plan in place. If a digital resource is having technical problems, it will not count against your child's grade. I will communicate with you in these circumstances and send home information or alternate work as needed.
