Mrs. Teddy's Tidbits

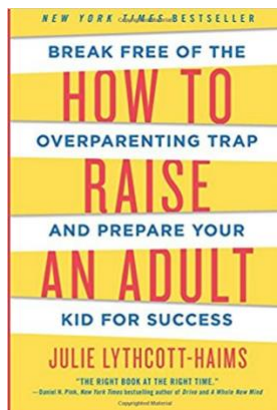
Good afternoon Falcon Families!

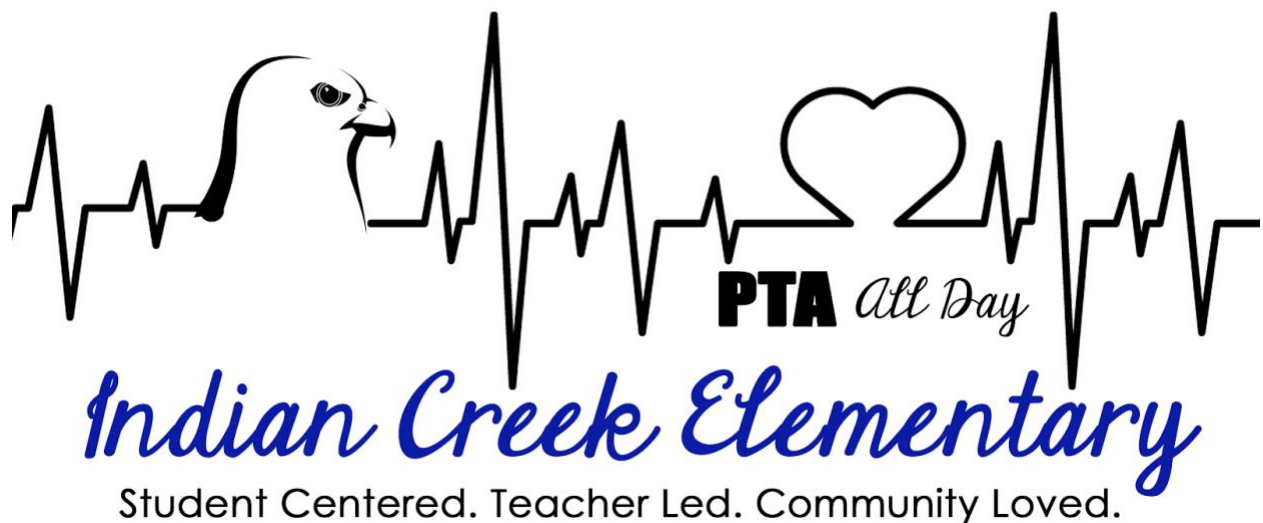

helps students expand their creativity and artistic expression, with the opportunity to gain local, state, and national recognition!

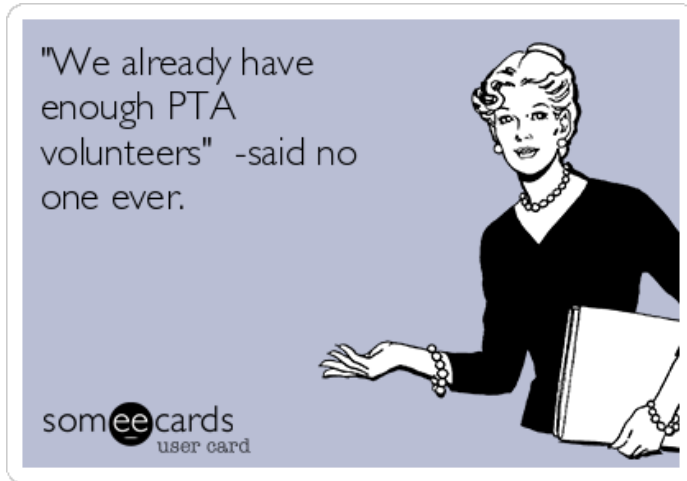
