Subject: Consider Approval of RFQ #02-0424-19 LISD Security Camera Data Storage

Background Information:

- This Security Camera Data Storage project implementation will be part of the 2017 Bond that was approved by voters on May 6, 2017. This project was presented to the Board of Trustees as part of the Bond Projects Timeline at the Board Workshop on June 7, 2017, and to the Board Technology Committee on December 12, 2017. The Board of Trustees approved Phase I at the November 13, 2017 Board of Trustees meeting and Phase II at the February 12, 2018 Board of Trustees meeting.
- This recommendation is for the Security Camera Data Storage Phase III. This final phase of the multi-phased project is to expand the security camera system across the District. This security camera storage will support the video management system and store data from the security cameras across the District.
- The Safety and Security Department worked with the Technology Department to define the specifications needed for this project. At the request of Safety and Security and Technology Departments, the Procurement and Contracts Department then obtained quotes from vendors who have been awarded a cooperative contract. Approximately 908 invitations were sent, and the District received three responses.

Administrative Consideration:

- This project funds will come from Safety and Security bond monies. The Technology Department will oversee the project implementation.
- Anticipated expenditures: \$850,000, but will not exceed the approved budget.
- This procurement complies with Section 44.031 of the Texas Education Code.

Recommendations:

- That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the anticipated expenditures and cooperative contract with the vendor listed below:
