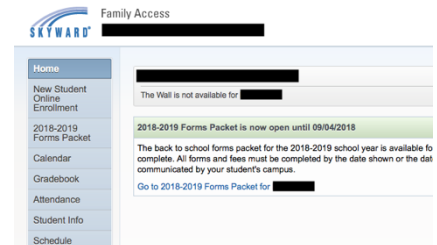

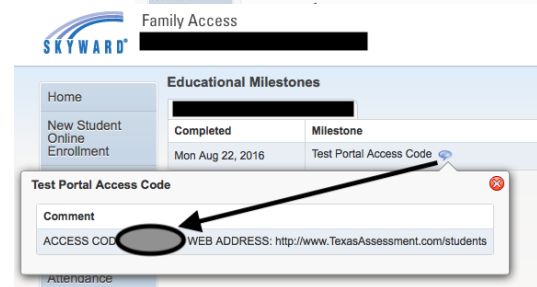


Parent Access to EOC Scores on the TEA Portal

1. Log into the web version of [Skyward Family Access](#) by clicking the Skyward icon at the top of [LISD.net](#).
2. Select the **Educational Milestones** Option on the left side of the screen. See image for help.



3. Click on the bubble next to **test portal access code** and write down your student's personal access code. It is a 6-digit code consisting of letters and numbers. See image for help.
4. Go to the TEA electronic portal here: <https://www.texasassessment.gov/>
5. Enter the **6-digit access code and your student's birthdate** to obtain his/her testing history.
6. To see more detailed information, click on the test name.
