#### **Dual Credit:**

Dual Credit offers students the opportunity to earn high school credit and college credit at the same time. Registration will open in the spring for Fall of 2024. Students new to dual credit will need to see their counselor to discuss the process of applying.

#### Senior Out/In:

Senior In/Out offers seniors the opportunity to have either 1st period or 4th period off. This is only available to seniors who have fulfilled graduation requirements.

#### **December Graduate:**

December Graduate allows seniors who have completed graduation requirements to graduate in December. December Graduates will walk the stage in May.

**APPLYING:** Most colleges use either Apply Texas ( <a href="https://goapplytexas.org/">https://goapplytexas.org/</a>) or Common App (<a href="https://www.commonapp.org/">https://www.commonapp.org/</a>) to apply to their school. Some schools utilize their own program, or a different process. It's a great idea to know admissions requirements for the universities you want to attend.

**FINANCIAL AID:** In October of your Senior year, be ready to complete your financial aid application (FAFSA or TASFA).

This is an online application based on your family's income that can qualify you for grants and loans. It will be available starting October 1st, 2024.
