

# **LHS Senior Year Timeline**

## **Fall (September-December)**

- Attend a college event/fair (virtual or in person)
- Start your senior year by finalizing your college list.
- Now that you have an idea of where you want to go, visit prospective colleges, and get a feel for the campuses. Be sure to check with the LHS Attendance Office concerning college visit days.
- Register for the SAT, ACT, or SAT subject test. Visit College Board or ACT to register.
- Fill out and complete your college applications before the deadlines. Common Application, SendU, or Apply Texas are great to use!
- Send an official transcript to the college(s) by using the Transcript Request form on the LHS Counseling website.
- Make an appointment with your school counselor to request a letter of recommendation for your college application.
- Start working on your college application essay
- Explore your prospective schools' financial aid department/website to plan your college budget.
- Attend the FAFSA meetings held by the LHS Counseling Department.
- Complete your FAFSA so you can get the most possible financial assistance for college. FAFSA opens Oct. 1<sup>st</sup> or the opt-out form if you choose not to fill out the FAFSA/TASFA.
- Regularly check the LHS Counseling website for scholarship postings.
- Complete the LEF (Lewisville Education Foundation) Scholarship application.

## **Spring (January-May)**

- Once you've received all your responses from college, make your final decision!
- Verify your financial aid before you make any college budget decisions.
- Register for Housing with the college; don't miss any deadlines!
- Be mindful of your grades and credits this semester!
- Request your FINAL TRANSCRIPT from LHS Registrar's office to send to your college. ALL students must send a final transcript. <https://lewisvilletx.scribborder.com/>
- Send any AP exam scores to the college you will attend.
- If you took Dual Credit classes, be sure to send a NCTC College transcript to your college.
- Male students aged 18 or older must register with Selective Service. <https://www.sss.gov/>
- All students aged 18 should register to VOTE!

## **Summer (June-August)**

- Register for your college orientation.
- Get a summer job to help with college expenses!
