



2021-2022 Lewisville High School PTSA Scholarship Overview

Lewisville High School PTSA is pleased to announce its Student Scholarship program for 2021-2022. The PTSA scholarships are designed to recognize LHS seniors who have demonstrated leadership, school and/or community involvement, and the desire to be successful at an accredited college, university or trade school.

Scholarships available to the LHS Class of 2022

These scholarships are available only to LHS seniors who are current PTSA members. Individual Scholarships are anticipated to be \$250 - \$500.

Minimum Criteria

These scholarships are competitive with the following minimum qualifications:

1. Must be enrolled at Lewisville High School at the time the scholarship application is submitted.
2. All requested information on the application must be received all at one time.
3. **Deadline to turn in completed application is Saturday, March 12, 2022.**
4. A full, complete application form includes:
 - a. Two letters of recommendations from teachers, or adults who are not family members.
 - b. An unofficial transcript.
5. Student PLUS one parent/legal guardian must be members of the LHS PTSA before the application can be turned in. **Both student and parent/guardian must be members no later than Saturday, March 12, 2022.**
6. If you still need to join the PTSA do so by going to www.joinpta.org
We are **Lewisville Senior High School PTSA.**
7. Must graduate from Lewisville High School during the 2021-2022 school year.
8. Must enroll in an accredited college, university, or trade school during the Fall 2022 semester.

Note: Financial need is not part of the application process; this is a merit scholarship.

How to Apply

During the week of January 31, 2022 Scholarship applications will be made available at <http://lhs.lisd.net>, or you can pick up a copy by visiting your guidance counselor. All directions are on the application form.

Deadline to turn in application is Saturday, March 12, 2022 . Instructions on how to submit completed applications are on the scholarship application. Recipients will be notified in late April and Awards Presentation will be during Senior Honor Celebration.

4. A full, complete application form includes:
 - a. Two letters of recommendations from teachers or adults who are *not* family members.
 - b. An unofficial transcript.
5. **Student PLUS one parent/legal guardian must be members of the LHS PTSA before the application can be turned in. Both student and parent/guardian must be members prior to application being turned in but, no later than Saturday, March 12, 2022.**
6. If you still need to join the PTSA do so by going to www.joinpta.org

7. Must graduate from Lewisville High School during the 2021-2022 school year.
8. Student must enroll in an accredited college, university, or trade school for the Fall 2022 semester.

The completed application must be submitted via email no later than 11:59 pm Saturday, March 12, 2022. Please follow direction in #2 above.
