In order to promote a partnership between the home and the school for improving the education of children participating in the federally funded Title 1 program, Stewart's Creek Elementary school will implement programs, activities, and procedures for the involvement of parents:

Stewart's Creek Elementary school will:

- Conduct an annual meeting to inform parents of their school's participation in the Title 1 program and explain the requirements and rights of the parents to be involved on November 5, 2020 at 5:00 pm. This information was distributed via Skyalert to parents of the notification of the meeting.
- Involve parents in an organized, on-going, and timely way in the planning, review and improvement of the Title 1 program through:
 - Parent involvement activities such as PTA meetings, Watch Dog program, etc.
 - School/ Parent / Teacher Compact
 - Building Leadership Team meetings where parents are encouraged to provide input about student and campus goals
 - Annual Title 1 Meetings that discuss the services and programs that governmental funded money provides
 - Family Education Nights where parents are encouraged to view and participate in sample classroom activities so as to see what their child is learning in the classroom
 - Parent/Teacher Conferences in the fall/spring and when needed to discuss the progress of their child's academic strengths and weaknesses.
 - Parent workshops focused on promoting student's success such as Love and Logic, Digital Citizenship, etc.

Parents will have the opportunity to participate in various surveys and/or meetings throughout the year in order to provide input regarding Title 1 planning, implementations and school improvement.
