# Note re: Dual Credit

- Must select all Dual Credit courses with a particular DC course/program (2-4 courses)
- Must fill out the Dual Credit Interest Form (linked on core course card and Course Selection Info webpage)
- Dual Credit has application/registration/payment process
- Requesting a class in Skyward doesn't mean you are officially in yet
- March 1st is the kickoff meeting for this process
  - DC Information Meeting via WebEx at 6pm
- If you have not completed enrollment/payment process by May 1st, your DC requests will be changed to HHS courses
- Pick HHS alternates for the DC courses you pick

# Senior Off, Office Aide, Early Grad

- Seniors Only
- Only 1 off period per semester
- You can just take 1 semester if you want
- You can switch periods each semester if you want
- Must request these just like any other class
- December Graduation is also a course...takes up 4 periods
- Must print off, sign and return appropriate forms to your counselor



# Alternates

- You MUST provide alternates
- Cut from sports/audition, class not offered, not enough space, etc
- Dual Credit backups
- Core course backups
- Provide 4-8 alternates...and put them in order
- Do not put the same classes in alternates that you have in top requests
- We use alternates for almost every student
- You don't put them....we pick them...
